I used my current address and looked up my voting information on the Texas Secretary of State website at <https://teamrv-mvp.sos.texas.gov/MVP/mvp.do>. My precinct number is _____ and my polling place is located at _____.

I pledge to vote in the midterm election for all offices listed up and down the ballot. Early voting is October 22 to November 2 and regular voting is November 6.

I will drive to the polls myself. If I don't have the car I will ask for a ride from _____ or take public transportation.

I have posted a message on social media reminding my friends to register at Vote411.org and show up to vote.

I have reviewed how to use the voting machines at VoteTexas.gov

I downloaded and printed my ballot and checked off the names of my candidates. Ballots will only be ready closer to the election at: www.vote411.org/ballot.

I have my ballot ready to take to my voting site.
